

RESOLUTION OF RAINS COUNTY AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE TEXAS COMPTROLLER FOR A RURAL LAW ENFORCEMENT SUPPORT GRANTS PROGRAM, SENATE BILL 22 (SB22) GRANT; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO ACT ON BEHALF OF RAINS COUNTY IN ALL MATTERS RELATED TO THE APPLICATION; AND PLEDGING THAT IF A GRANT IS RECEIVED RAINS COUNTY WILL COMPLY WITH THE GRANT REQUIREMENTS OF THE COMPTROLLER AND THE STATE OF TEXAS.


WHEREAS, the Comptroller is directed by the State of Texas to administer SB22 grant funds for implementation of the Rural Law Enforcement Support Grants Program; and

WHEREAS, Rains County in the State of Texas is qualified to apply for grant funds under the Request for Applications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY RAINS COUNTY IN EMORY, TEXAS;

1. That the County Judge is authorized to request grant funding under the SB22 Request for Applications of the Rural Law Enforcement Support Grants Program and act on behalf of Rains County in all matters related to the grant application, reporting, and any subsequent grant contract and grant project that may result.
2. That if the project is funded, Rains County will comply with the grant requirements of the Comptroller and the State of Texas.
3. The grant funds and any grant-funded equipment or facilities will be used only for the purposes for which they are intended under the grant.
4. That activities will comply with and support the SB22 Rural Law Enforcement Support Grants Program.


