RESOLUTION OF RAINS COUNTY AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (DOT) FOR A GRANTS PROGRAM, BUILD GRANT; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO ACT ON BEHALF OF RAINS COUNTY IN ALL MATTERS RELATED TO THE APPLICATION; AND PLEDGING THAT IF A GRANT IS RECEIVED, RAINS COUNTY WILL COMPLY WITH THE GRANT REQUIREMENTS OF THE DOT AND GRANT MANAGEMENT STANDARDS.


WHEREAS, the DOT is directed by the U.S. Congress to administer BUILD grant funds for implementation of the Grants Program; and

WHEREAS, Rains County in the State of Texas is qualified to apply for grant funds under the Request for Applications.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY RAINS COUNTY IN EMORY, TEXAS;

1. That the County Judge, the Authorized Official (AO), is authorized to request grant funding under the DOT Request for Applications of the Grants Program and act on behalf of Rains County in all matters related to the grant application, reporting, and any subsequent grant contract and grant project that may result, and the County Treasurer, the Financial Officer (FO), is authorized to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of Rains County.
2. That if the project is funded, Rains County will comply with the grant requirements of the DOT and the Grant Management Standards.
3. The grant funds and any grant-funded equipment or facilities will be used only for the purposes for which they are intended under the grant.


