

RESOLUTION OF RAINS COUNTY AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR (OOG) FOR A SHERIFF'S OFFICE SUPPORT GRANTS PROGRAM, HOMELAND SECURITY (HS) GRANT; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO ACT ON BEHALF OF RAINS COUNTY IN ALL MATTERS RELATED TO THE APPLICATION; AND PLEDGING THAT IF A GRANT IS RECEIVED RAINS COUNTY WILL COMPLY WITH THE GRANT REQUIREMENTS OF THE OOG AND THE STATE OF TEXAS.


WHEREAS, the OOG is directed by the State of Texas to administer HS grant funds for implementation of the Sheriff's Office Support Grants Program; and

WHEREAS, Rains County in the State of Texas is qualified to apply for grant funds under the Request for Applications.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY RAINS COUNTY IN EMORY, TEXAS;

1. That the County Judge, the Authorized Official (AO), is authorized to request grant funding under the OOG Request for Applications of the Sheriff's Office Support Grants Program and act on behalf of Rains County in all matters related to the grant application, reporting, and any subsequent grant contract and grant project that may result, and the County Treasurer, the Financial Officer (FO), is authorized to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of Rains County.
2. That if the project is funded, Rains County will comply with the grant requirements of the OOG and the State of Texas.
3. The grant funds and any grant-funded equipment or facilities will be used only for the purposes for which they are intended under the grant.
4. That the County will not decrease funding to the Sheriff's Office because of receiving grant funds.





RESOLUTION OF RAINS COUNTY AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR (OOG) FOR A PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE (PSO) PROGRAM, HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM – REGULAR PROJECTS (SHSP-R) GRANT; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO ACT ON BEHALF OF RAINS COUNTY IN ALL MATTERS RELATED TO THE APPLICATION; AND PLEDGING THAT IF A GRANT IS RECEIVED RAINS COUNTY WILL COMPLY WITH THE GRANT REQUIREMENTS OF THE OOG AND THE STATE OF TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the OOG is directed by the State of Texas to administer PSO grant funds for implementation of the SHSP-R Grant Program with the grant application titled Mobile Incident Command Trailer; and

WHEREAS, Rains County in the State of Texas is qualified to apply for grant funds under the Request for Applications.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY RAINS COUNTY IN EMORY, TEXAS;

1. That the County Judge, the Authorized Official (AO), is authorized to request grant funding under the OOG Request for Applications of the Sheriff's Office Support Grants Program and act on behalf of Rains County in all matters related to and authorizing applying for, accepting, rejecting, altering, or terminating the grant, and any subsequent grant contract and grant project that may result, and the County Treasurer, the Financial Officer (FO), is authorized to submit financial and/or performance reports or alter a grant on behalf of Rains County.
2. That if the project is funded, Rains County will comply with the grant requirements of the OOG and the State of Texas and commits to provide all applicable matching funds.
3. The grant funds and any grant-funded equipment or facilities will be used only for the purposes for which they are intended under the grant and in the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the governing body will return all funds to PSO.
4. That the County will not decrease funding to the Sheriff's Office because of receiving grant funds.




