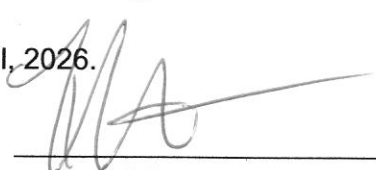
WHEREAS, this grant program will assist Rains County in preserving the historic courthouse; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Grant Development is designated as the Program Director and the Rains County Treasurer is designated as the Financial Officer for this grant.

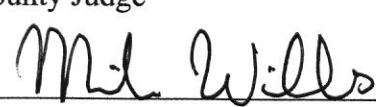

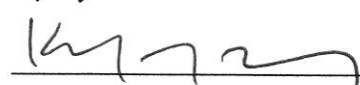

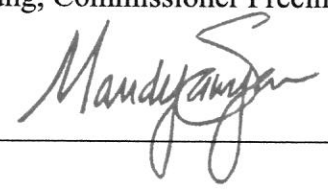
