**ORDER FOR CREATION OF OFFICE OF COUNTY FIRE MARSHAL
7926IV.B.3**

WHEREAS, Section 352.011, Local Government Code provides that the commissioners court of a county may establish the office of county fire marshal and provide office facilities, equipment, transportation, assistants, and professional services for that office; and.

WHEREAS, the Rains County Commissioners Court finds that the creation of the office of county fire marshal will be beneficial to the health and safety of the citizens of Rains County, Texas;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The office of Rains County Fire Marshall is hereby created effective immediately to serve a term of office expiring October 1, 2026, without compensation.
2. The Commissioners Court shall by future order determine the term of office, not to exceed two years, and any compensation for the fiscal year, beginning October 1, 2026.

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF RAINS COUNTY, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF COUNTY FIRE MARSHAL

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Rains County, Texas, finds that it is in the public interest to establish the Office of County Fire Marshal; and

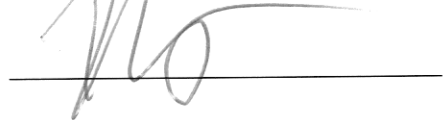
WHEREAS, Section 352.011 of the Texas Local Government Code authorizes the Commissioners Court to establish the office of county fire marshal and set the term of office, which may not exceed two years; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court desires to provide for the efficient administration of fire prevention, fire investigation, and related public safety duties within the county;

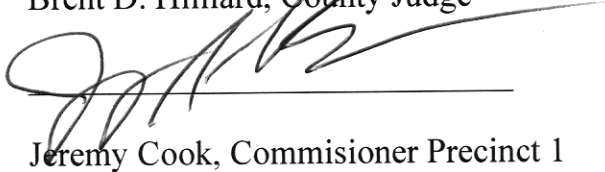
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF RAINS COUNTY, TEXAS, THAT:

1. The Office of County Fire Marshal is hereby established for Rains County, Texas.
2. The Commissioners Court may provide office facilities, equipment, transportation, assistants, and professional services as needed for the office, consistent with law.
3. The County Fire Marshal shall serve a term not to exceed two years, as established by the Commissioners' Court.
4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

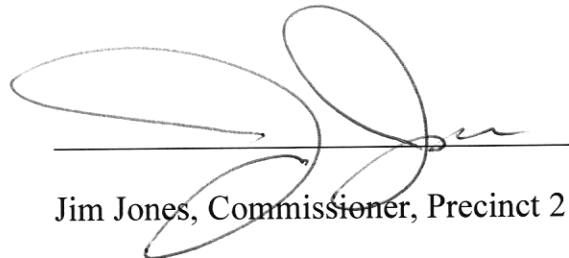

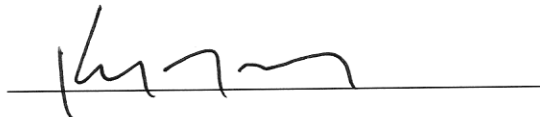

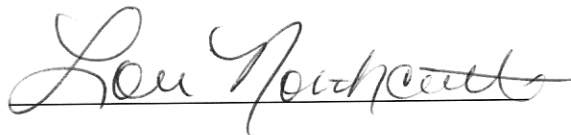
Jeremy Cook, Commissioner Precinct 1
