Having created the office of county fire marshal pursuant to Section 352.011, Local Government Code, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

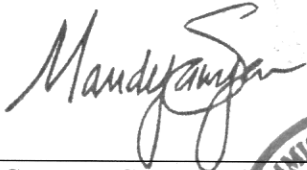
1. David Shedd is hereby appointed to serve as Rains County Fire Marshal for a term expiring October 1, 2026 without compensation.

**RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF RAINS COUNTY,
TEXAS
APPOINTING THE RAINS COUNTY FIRE MARSHAL**

WHEREAS, the Commissioner's Court of Rains County, Texas, finds that it is in the best interest of the County to appoint a Fire Marshal to support public safety, fire prevention, inspections, and related enforcement duties within Rains County; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court desires to formally appoint a qualified individual to serve as the Rains County Fire Marshal; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court has determined that the appointment of a Fire Marshal is necessary and appropriate for the efficient operation of county government and the protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Rains County;

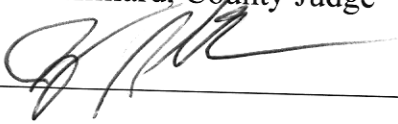
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF RAINS COUNTY, TEXAS:

1. **Appointment.** The Commissioners Court hereby appoints David Shedd as the **Rains County Fire Marshal**, effective July 9, 2026.
2. **Authority and Duties.** The Fire Marshal shall perform such duties and responsibilities as assigned by the Commissioners Court, county policy, and applicable law, including fire prevention, inspections, investigations, and related public safety functions.
3. **Term and Compensation.** The term of appointment and compensation, if any, shall be as approved by the Commissioners' Court and reflected in county records and budget authority.
4. **Administration.** The County Judge and County Clerk are authorized to take any administrative actions necessary to implement this resolution.

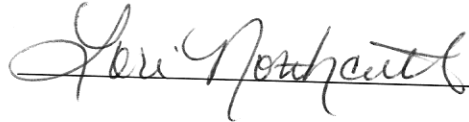
