

2026 LEPC Grant Resolution

WHEREAS, Rains County finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Rains County that the LEPC grant program be operated for the 26-27 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Rains County agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the LEPC grant application; and

WHEREAS, Rains County agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of TECQ's funds, Rains County assures that the funds will be returned to TCEQ in full.

WHEREAS, Rains County designates the Rains County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

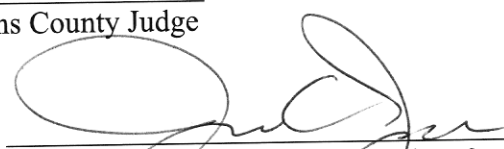

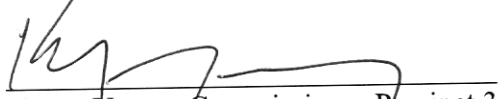
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Rains County approves submission of the grant application for the 2026 LEPC grant to TCEQ.

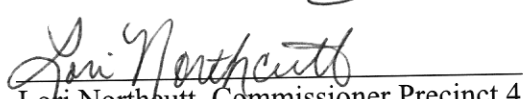
