

26-27 House Bill 3000 (HB 3000) Grant Resolution

WHEREAS, Rains County finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Rains County that the 26-27 HB 3000 grant program be operated for the 26-27 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Rains County agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the Texas Comptroller grant application; and

WHEREAS, Rains County agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Texas Comptroller funds, Rains County assures that the funds will be returned to the Texas Comptroller in full.

WHEREAS, Rains County designates the Rains County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

WHEREAS, Rains County designates the Rains County Treasurer as the grantee's financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Rains County approves submission of the grant application for the 26-27 HB 3000 grant program to the Comptroller.
